

ALEJANDRO SEJANOVICH

Alejandro is acknowledged as one of the most prestigious winemakers of Argentina. He was born in Mendoza, growing up surrounded by vines. No surprise he got his calling when he was only thirteen years old.

Graduated with a Gold Medal in Agricultural Engineering (or graduated with a Gold Medal as an Agricultural expert) in Mendoza along with a Master Degree in oenology from the Montpellier University in France. One day he becomes part of the Catena Zapata staff and it is there that he had the opportunity to walk several vineyards and know several grape growers all along the country. His main focus was placed on microclimates, soil composition and how these factors influence the process of winemaking.

Then he met Alejandro Vigil, another member of Catena's staff of winemakers, and both did a lot of research on new wine producing regions in Mendoza, such as Altamira and Gualtallary in Uco Valley.
